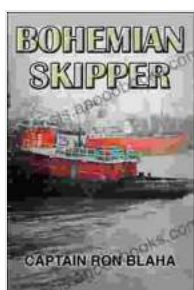


# Bohemian Skipper: A Journey Down the James River

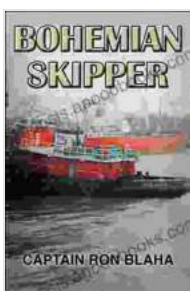
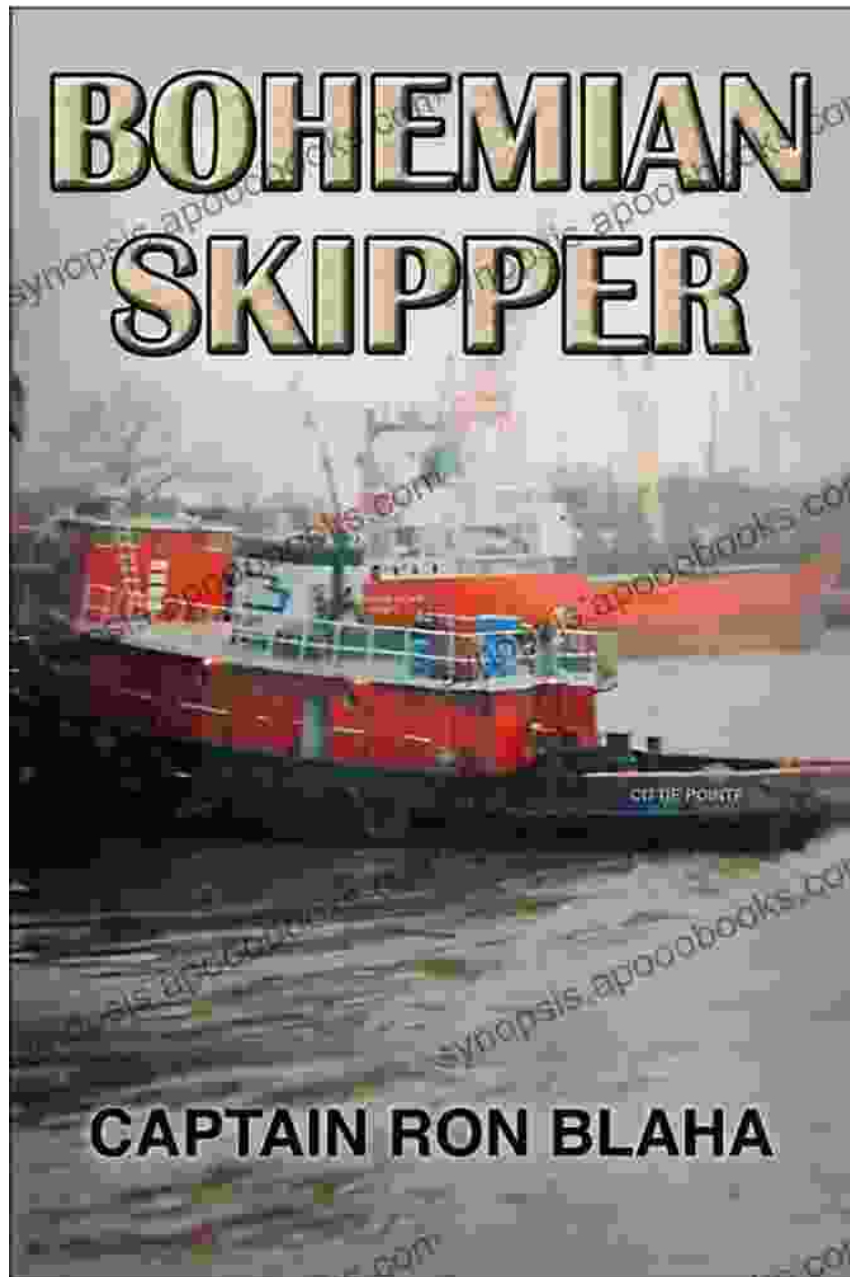
