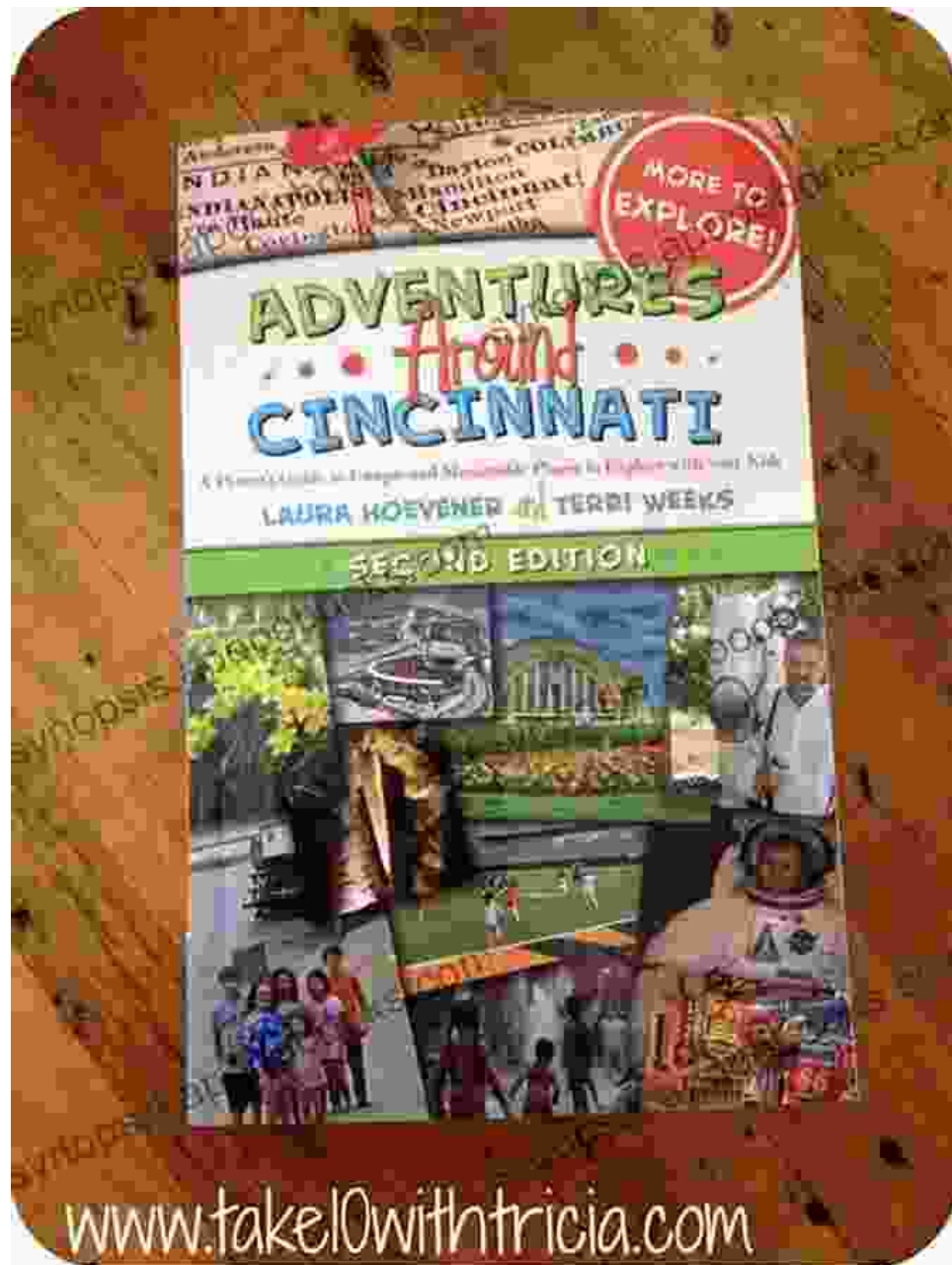


1. Visit the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden

2. Explore Eden Park



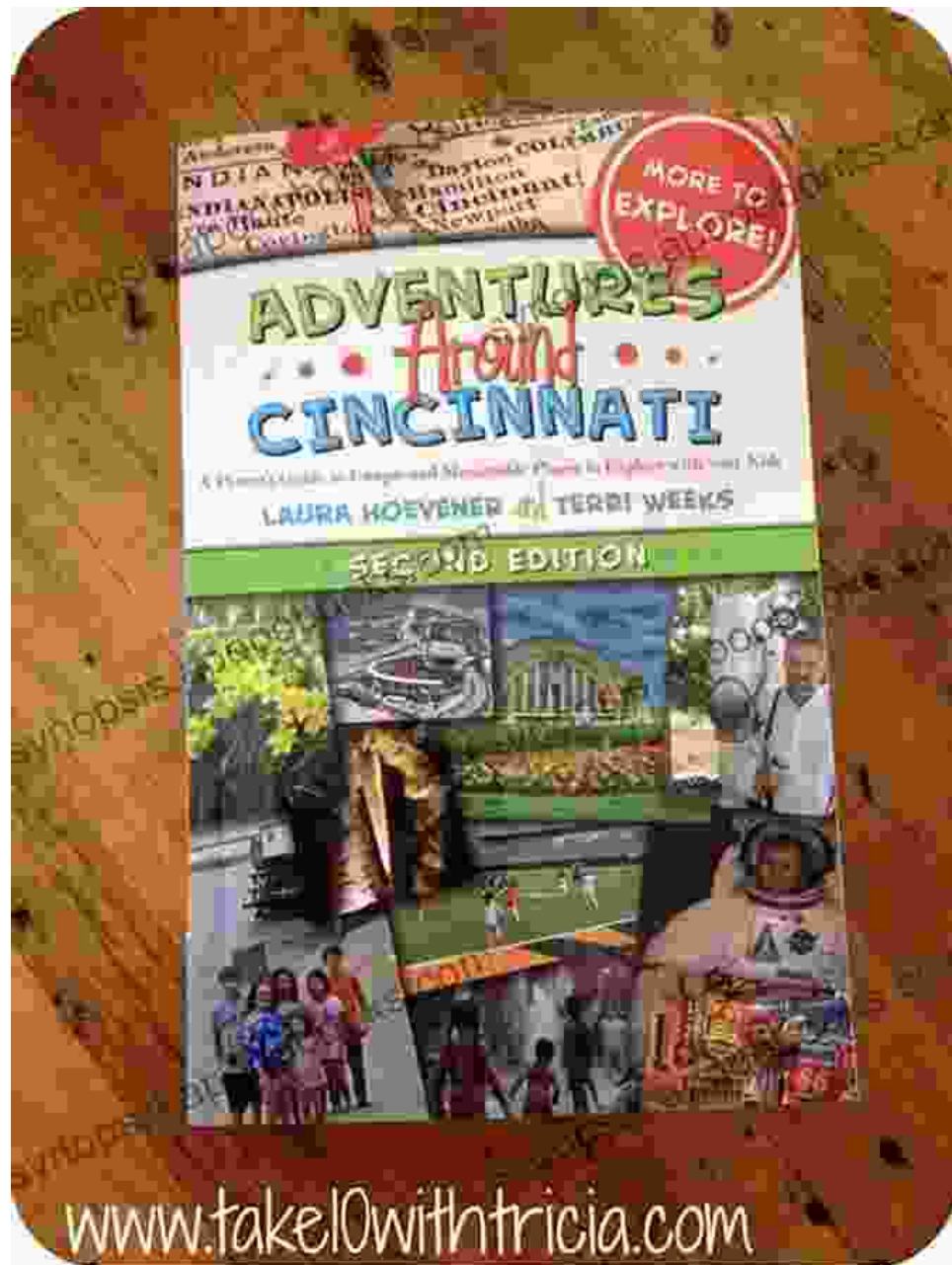

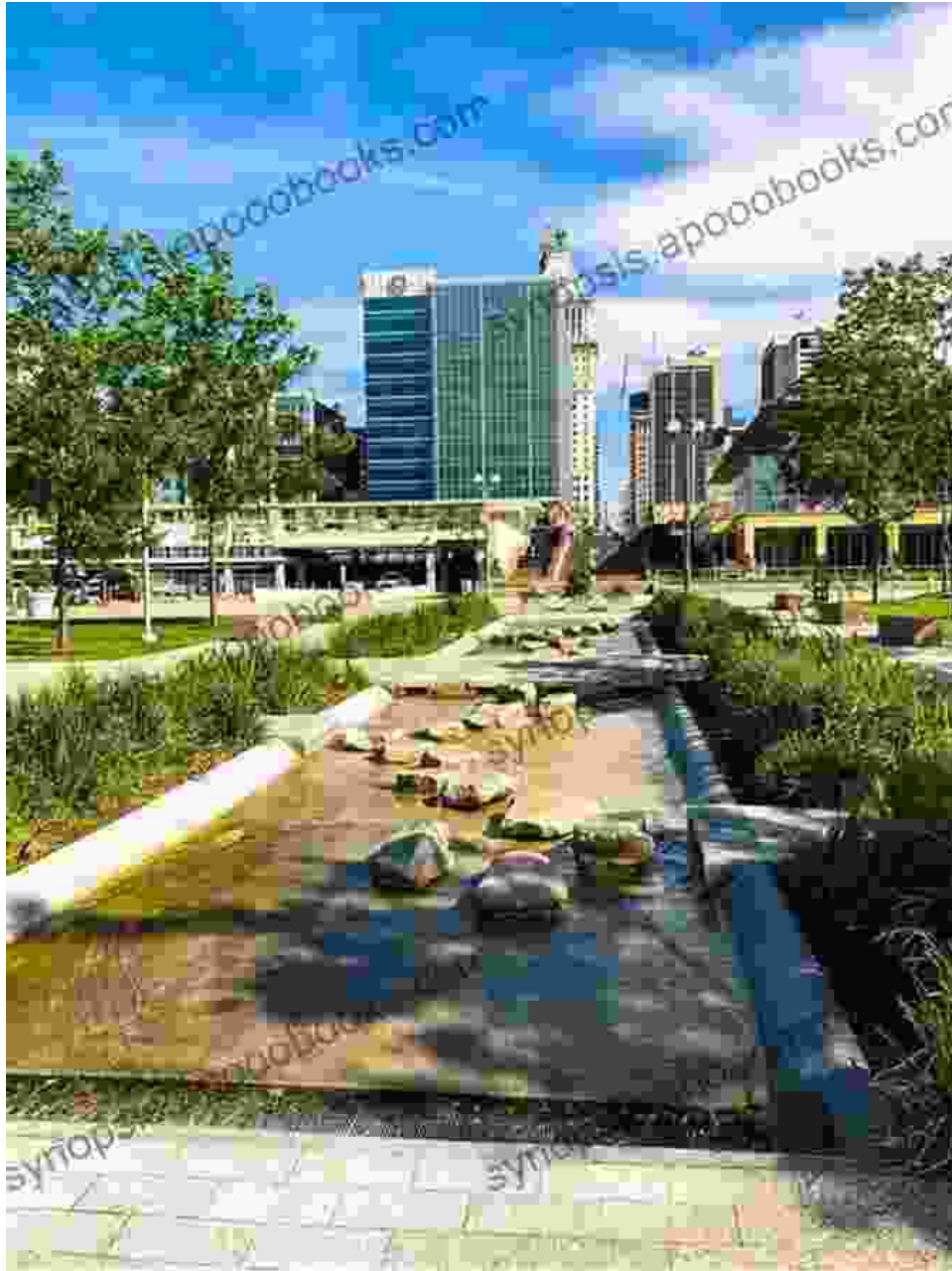
