## Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn in four colors (we recommend using a soft, durable yarn like acrylic or cotton)
- Crochet hook in size H (5.00mm)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

## Step-by-Step Instructions

### Creating the Granny Squares

1. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet), 2 double crochet in ring, chain 2, 3 double crochet in ring, \*chain 2, 3 double crochet in ring; repeat from \* three times more.
3. Round 2: Chain 3, 2 double crochet in corner space, chain 2, \*3 double crochet in next corner space, chain 2; repeat from \* three times more.
4. Repeat Round 2 until the square measures about 6 inches.
5. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

### Creating the Granny Stripe

1. Chain 100.
2. Row 1: Single crochet in second chain from hook and in each chain across. Turn.
3. Row 2: Chain 1, single crochet in each stitch across. Turn.
4. Repeat Row 2 until the stripe measures about 6 inches.

5. Fasten off.

## **Assembling the Afghan**

1. Lay out the granny squares and granny stripes in the desired pattern.
2. Using the yarn needle, sew the squares and stripes together, starting from the center and working outwards.
3. Once all the pieces are sewn together, fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.

## **Finishing Touches**

To give your afghan a polished look, you can add a bFree Download or edging. This can be done using a variety of crochet stitches, such as a single crochet bFree Download or a picot edging. You can also add tassels or fringe to further enhance the beauty of your creation.

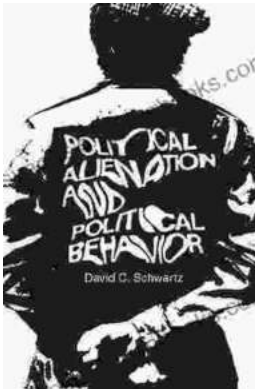
